English

Our writing this term will include:

We will also be completing weekly times table tests for both year groups.

Science

Our science topic this term is all about Brilliant Bubbles. In this topic we will look at solids, liquids and gases and how these link to different types of bubbles. We will then look at what makes a bubble and have a go at making our own. We will finish the topic by looking at the types of bubbles we may find in certain types of food and drink.






RE

In RE we will be exploring what it is like for a Hindu living in Britain today.

PE

In PE we will be focusing on dance and gymnastics as well as continuing our swimming.



History

In history we are looking at the impact World War Two had on children. As part of this topic, we also have a WW2 cookery session with Kitchen Club and a visit to the STEAM museum.

Computing

In computing we will be looking at espresso coding which will help the children to understand simple coding to create their own programs/apps.

Art

In art, the children will begin by using tone to create '3D' images. They will then work on creating a sense of proportion and using mixed media, wax resist and printing to create images.

Music

In music the children will begin by looking at different genres of music before focussing on a singing technique. They will look at identifying the pitch of notes and how to sing in parts, before notating a piece of music.

RSHE

In RSHE we will be learning about valuing differences. The key element to this topic is respect and how we can show this to everyone.

French

In French we will be learning how to remember and name pets in French.
