Shema An ancient Jewish prayer that can be found in the Torah.	Shabbat Shabbat is Judaism's day of rest on the seventh day of the week. This is on a Saturday. On this day, religious Jews remember stories from the bible.
Sukkot A big Jewish festival held in Autumn giving thanks for the Autumn harvest.	Hannukah/Channukah A Jewish festival of light lasting eight days. It usually happens in November or December.
