

Key Vocabulary		  
New Testament	The part of the Bible that tells Christians about Jesus.	
Old Testament	The part of the Bible that comes before Jesus and tells Christians about God creating Earth.	
Faith	Complete trust or confidence in someone or something.	
Commandment	A divine rule, especially one of the Ten Commandments.	
Worship	The feeling or expression of reverence and adoration for a deity.	
Obedience	Obedience signifies deep trust and respect for God, believing that He knows best.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Most Christians are monotheists (they believe in one God). • The Old Testament is the original Hebrew Bible, the sacred scriptures of the Jewish faith. • For Christians, faith means personal trust and belief in God. • Christians understand the Ten Commandments as divine moral guidelines. • Christian worship is the act of showing honour, praise, and love to God. • Christian obedience stems from love for God and thankfulness for salvation.
