#### GCC MEAL VOUCHERS

Gloucestershire County Council will provide families in receipt of Free School Meals (FSM), who sign up, with vouchers to assist with food costs during the school holidays. Families who have signed up to the scheme, or who are already registered will be supported with food costs with vouchers for a value of £15 per eligible child per qualifying week, during the school holidays.

Vouchers for the October 2024 holiday period are being distributed week commencing 30 September 2024. Families who signed up will have receive a total of £15 per eligible child, for one week.

Applications for free school meal holiday vouchers for the October 2024 half term holiday are open from midday 2 September 2024 until midday 20 September 2024.
