

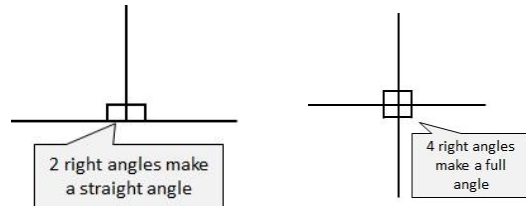
Year 5 Term 6 Key Instant Recall Facts

Geometry - key facts

There are 360° in a full turn.
 There are 180° on a straight line.
 There are 90° in a right angle.

In order to solve problems with shape and angles, you will need to remember these key facts about degrees.

To help remember this, you can use your knowledge that a right angle is 90° . There are 2 right angles to make a line, and 4 right angles in a full turn.



Be able to identify these quadrilaterals by their properties:

- Square
- Oblong (rectangle)
- Parallelogram
- Trapezium
- Rhombus
- Kite

parallelogram



2 pairs of equal sides
 Diagonally opposite angles are equal

trapezium



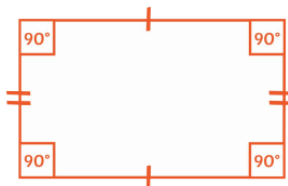
1 pair of sides are parallel

rhombus



All sides are equal
 Diagonally opposite angles are equal

rectangle



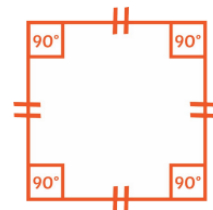
2 pairs of equal parallel sides
 4 right angles (90°)

kite



2 pairs of sides of equal length
 1 pair of opposite angles is equal.

square



4 equal parallel sides
 4 right angles (90°)
