ATTENDANCE – SCHOOL DAYS MISSED

Attendance in school is key to our children's learning. Since September 2024 there have been 243 morning or afternoon sessions missed. This is equivalent to 121.5 days of education. FEBRUARY HALF TERM VOUCHER SCHEME

For February 2025 half term, Gloucestershire County Council will provide families in receipt of Free School Meals, who sign up to this offer, with vouchers to assist with food costs during the school holidays. Families who sign up to the scheme or who are already registered will receive a total of £15 per eligible child.

Families not already registered to receive holiday FSM vouchers can make an application from midday 27 January until midday on 7 February.

To make a new application please submit a query via the Microsoft Form <u>HERE</u>.

*Please note the scheme is for children in reception to year 11 who receive Pupil Premium (income-related) free school meals and attend a school in Gloucestershire. We are unable to consider college and sixth form students, nor children who receive infant free school meals (available to all children from reception to year 2) - they are not eligible for this scheme.

Voucher code emails will be sent from week commencing 10 February. If you have not received your vouchers by 17 February, submit a query via the Microsoft Form <u>HERE</u>. Please check your emails including junk/spam folders during this period as sometimes the vouchers end up there.
