Key Vocabulary

Census	A census is a count of people in an area which tells us something.
Population	The population is the number of people living in a place.
Survey	A survey is when you ask people questions to find out what they think or do.
Denomination	A denomination means a group within a religion that shares the same beliefs, but do things slightly differently.
Observation	An observation is when you look at something carefully to find out more about it.
Interviews	An interview is a special kind of conversation where one person asks questions and another person answers them.
